DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Space Spray: Use **CARIBBEAN BREEZE** straight and spray in a wide trigger spray pattern setting towards the center of the room. **Contact Spray:** Use **CARIBBEAN BREEZE** straight and spray in a wide trigger spray pattern directly on the source of the malodor.

Mop Additive Solution: Use **CARIBBEAN BREEZE** at a dilution of 2 oz. to 8 oz. per gallon.

Extraction Additive: Use **CARIBBEAN BREEZE** at a dilution of 2 oz. to 8 oz. per gallon.

Carpet and Upholstery Spray: Use **CARIBBEAN BREEZE** at a dilution of 2 oz. to 8 oz. per quart for general use.

Precautions

Precautions for Safe Handling

Wash hands and other exposed areas with mild soap and water before eating, drinking or smoking and when leaving work. Provide good ventilation in process area to prevent formation of vapor.

In case of fire: Use ABC-powder to extinguish. Store in well-ventilated place. Keep cool. Dispose of contents/container to an approved waste disposal plant. Firefighting Instructions: Use water spray or fog for cooling exposed containers. Exercise caution when fighting any chemical fire. Prevent fire-fighting water from entering environment. Suitable extinguishing media: Foam, dry powder, Carbon dioxide, water spray, sand.

FIRST AID

Never give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. If you feel unwell, seek medical advice. (Show label where possible.)
Inhalation: Allow victim to breath fresh air. Allow victim to rest. **Skin Contact:** Remove affected clothing and wash all exposed skin area with mild soap and water, followed by warm water rinse. **Eye Contact:** Rinse cautiously with water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present and easy to do. Continue rinsing. Get medical attention/advice. **Ingestion:** Rinse mouth. **DO NOT** induce vomiting. Obtain emergency medical attention.
