As raw sewage flows into lift station wells to be pumped to treatment facility, accumulation of sewage, grease, oils, fatty acids and calcium and magnesium soaps form deposits on the walls. These deposits reduce volume capacity of wet wells, and by their natural decomposition process, emit offensive odors. To return lift station to optimum efficiency, this accumulation of debris must be removed or substantially reduced.

FUNCTION

Highly specialized **MEGA LIFT** is a fast-breaking emulsification system possessing degreasing and detergent properties which clean the vertical surfaces of lift station wet wells for effortless cleaning. Cleaning and degreasing are accomplished by the rise and fall of the water level. As the water level fluctuates, the cleaner removes the debris from the sides of the wet well. A secondary property of this unique product is its ability to "seal" or contain offensive odors that emit from the lift station.

DIRECTIONS

MEGA LIFT should be added to wet well until a layer of 8-to-12 inches is floating on the surface. This initial treatment should remain effective for a period of 3-to-6 months, depending upon system demands.

PRECAUTIONS
